Mission Statement of the OMCA Education Foundation

Purpose of the OMCA Education Foundation

Tuition Award/Bursary

The OMCA Education Foundation has a limited amount of funds that it will use to provide tuition awards/bursaries to chosen students. The amount of the tuition award/bursary will vary depending on need and the number of qualified applicants. In 2010, we awarded eight students with the \$1,000 awards/bursaries.

Selection Criteria

An average of 3.0 / B or higher is required. Winners will be selected based upon academic performance, interest or active roll in the industry and financial need will be taken into consideration.

Selection of successful applicants is at the sole discretion of the OMCA Education Foundation and all decisions are final.
