

OMCA Hall of Fame - 2012

Purpose of Award

This award recognizes those individuals who are pioneers and who have made a significant contribution to the motor coach industry.

Qualification Criteria

Bus Operators

1. Minimum of 25 years service to the motor coach industry.
2. Minimum of 20 years service in a management capacity with an operating company.

Tour Operators

1. Minimum of 15 years service in the travel/tour business.
2. An individual who conforms to the OMCA Code of Ethics.
3. Minimum of 10 years as a member of OMCA.
4. Significant contribution to the industry as a leader and innovator.

Instructions for Nominations

Bus Operators

Nominations must be made by an OMCA bus operator member and supported by five (5) other operator members.

Tour Operators

Nominations must be made by an OMCA tour operator or supplier member and supported by one (1) other tour operator or supplier member.

Bus and Tour Operators:

- a) Please provide details on the above criteria using the form following these instructions.
- b) A historical outline indicating the nominee's involvement in the industry must be attached to the nomination form; it must document the nominee's contributions and achievements over the years.
- c) Please include any other details that the Awards Committee should consider in determining the merits of the nomination.
- d) The Awards Committee will select a maximum of three (3) nominees per year.

Evaluation Guidelines

When a nomination has met the "Qualification Criteria" listed on this page, the Awards Committee will also consider the following:

- a) contribution to the nominee's company(s).
- b) contribution to the nominee's community.

Awards/Prizes

Each winner(s) of this award will:

- ◆ Receive a special personalized recognition award at the OMCA Awards Banquet
- ◆ Have a framed picture placed in the OMCA office
- ◆ Receive a limited edition OMCA lapel pin
- ◆ Receive industry and external publicity

All nomination forms must be returned to OMCA no later than Sept. 14, 2012
