

Supplier Member Award of Distinction - 2010

Purpose of Award

The Affiliate Member Award of Distinction recognizes an Affiliate member of OMCA who has provided an outstanding contribution and commitment to OMCA and the motor coach industry as a whole over an extended period of time.

Qualification Criteria

1. Candidates will be an employee of an Affiliate member of OMCA.
2. Candidate must have exhibited an outstanding commitment to OMCA for a minimum of the last five (5) years through their participation in Association events, activities, committees, etc.
3. Candidate must have a minimum of 10 years service in the industry.
4. Candidate has shown special interest and dedication to the overall motor coach industry.

Instructions for Nominations

1. Any OMCA member can make nominations.
2. Please read and complete all the information on the nomination form carefully to ensure all questions are answered and attachments included; the more complete the response provided in each category, the more information the Awards Committee will have to consider.
3. Please note that once an individual has won this award, their name may not be submitted again.

Evaluation Guidelines

The following point system was developed to give equal opportunity to all Affiliate Members. All candidates will be assessed equally under the following guidelines and in relation to the "Qualification Criteria" listed on this page:

1. Points not applicable.
2. Minimum 10 points available for 5 years of outstanding commitment to OMCA, with 5 points available for each additional consecutive year of participation in Association events, activities, committees, etc.
3. Minimum 10 points available for 10 years of service in the industry, with 5 points available for each additional consecutive year of employment in the industry.
4. Five (5) points awarded for each proven instance of special interest to the overall motor coach industry.

When a nomination has met the above criteria, the Awards Committee will also consider the following:

- a) Personal achievements within the industry.
- b) Corporate achievements attained on behalf of the employer by the nominee.
- c) Reputation, popularity and respect in the motor coach industry by colleagues and peers.

The winner(s) of this award will receive:

- A special personalized recognition award
- Complimentary admission for winner and a guest to attend the OMCA Annual Awards Banquet/Dance
- A limited edition OMCA lapel pin
- Industry and external publicity
