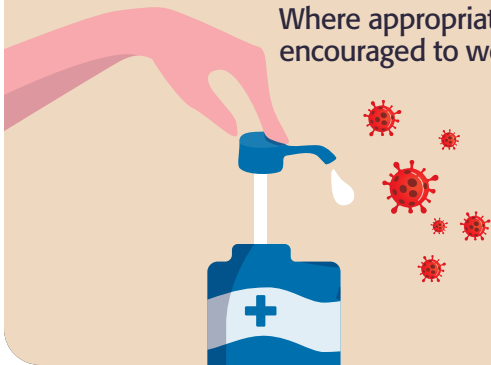

Companies have implemented a 24 point check list of all cleaning procedures to clean and disinfect motor coaches.

After each tour, we ensure all cleaning and PPE supplies are replenished.



Drivers self-monitor and have a duty to report symptoms. Drivers are also required to frequently wash their hands or use alcohol based hand sanitizer. Where appropriate, drivers are encouraged to wear gloves.



Coach and tour operators encourage all passengers to wear face coverings for the entire duration of their trip, including prior to boarding and to use hand sanitizer.



Coach and tour operators work closely with passengers on a case by case basis to accommodate social distancing.
